"AWIM Master Teacher Training Workshop 2011" was conducted at *R&D Ambad Annex*, Nasik on *Saturday*, 6<sup>th</sup> August 2010 from 8:30am to 5:30pm. *Twenty one teachers* of Nashik schools participated along with *Mahindra & Mahindra volunteers* in the workshop.

A World in Motion (AWIM) is a physical science program, developed by SAE International in 1990, which aims to promote science and mathematics literacy of students in standard fifth through eight by providing curriculum materials for authentic engineering design activities in the classroom that support a multidisciplinary, cooperative working experience.
